## Publication Guidelines:

- ❖ **Originality:** The proposed research paper must not be extracted from another academic work (book, dissertation, or thesis) and must not have been published or be under consideration for publication in another journal. Adherence to research ethics, including objectivity and academic integrity, is required, and any form of offensive content with ethnic, religious, racial, or linguistic bias must be avoided.
- ❖ **Author Information:** Details about the author(s) should be included below the title in font size 12 and must contain the following elements: name and surname, academic rank, affiliated institution, and email address.
- ❖ **Abstract:** The research paper must be accompanied by two abstracts: one in Arabic and the other in English (maximum 150 words each). The abstract should briefly include the following: introduction to the topic, presentation of the research problem, methodology used to address the problem, and key findings (limited to two lines each). Both abstracts should be accompanied by up to five keywords.
- ❖ **Research Methodology:** The introduction of the research paper should include the following elements: the main research problem, the study hypothesis, and the methodology adopted. The conclusion (limited to two paragraphs) should summarize the main findings in light of the research problem.
- ❖ **Paper Length:** The research paper should be between 4,000 and 5,500 words, including footnotes, tables, illustrations, and the reference list.
- ❖ **Font and Formatting:**
  - For papers in **Arabic:** Font type: Sakkal Majalla, size: 11.
  - For papers in **English** or **French:** Font type: Calibri, size: 10.
  - **Paper Title:** Font size: 14.
  - **Abstract:** Arabic abstract font size: 11; English abstract font size: 10.
  - **Line spacing:** 1.0.

- **Paragraph spacing:** 6 pt.
- ❖ **Page Settings:** Margins should be set as follows:
  - Top and bottom margins: 5 cm.
  - Right and left margins: 4.5 cm.
- ❖ **Citation Guidelines:**
  - **In-text citation:** References should be cited immediately after presenting the idea using the following format:
    - Example: (Smith, 2019, p. 138) or (Smith, 2019, pp. 138-139).
  - **Reference List:** A detailed reference list should be included at the end of the main text of the research paper, arranged alphabetically by the surname of the author(s) and following APA style. Examples:
    - **Book:**

    - **Edited Book:**

❖ **Peer Review Process:**

Submitted research papers are forwarded to a scientific review board comprising specialized researchers from Algerian and international universities. The board evaluates the papers to determine their suitability for publication under one of the following conditions: Accepted without modifications; Accepted with minor modifications; Accepted with substantial; modifications; Rjected, with reasons provided. Feedback from the reviewers is shared with the authors, who must adhere to the comments and resubmit the final version to the editorial board. The editorial team ensures confidentiality throughout the process, maintaining the anonymity of both the authors and the peer reviewers.
